






METRO Gold Line Schedule Overview



Completed project milestones

-  Washington and Ramsey Counties and the five cities to be served by the METRO Gold Line Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) joined with local community and business leaders to **choose the nine-mile route through Saint Paul, Maplewood, Oakdale, Landfall and Woodbury.**
-  The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) **accepted the Gold Line project** into its New Starts program, which funds transit projects across the country.
-  Ensure ongoing community input by **establishing advisory committees** so they can give advice to project staff:
-  Created a **Corridor Management Committee** made up of representatives from the Metropolitan Council, Metro Transit, MnDOT, Washington and Ramsey Counties, along with the five cities the line will serve.
-  Created a **Community and Business Advisory Committee** made up of neighborhood residents and local business representatives.
-  **Committee meetings** are scheduled regularly and open to the public, and meeting materials are available online.


Activities in progress

-  **Engage the public** with ongoing open houses and events designed to provide information about the Gold Line project and to gather input and advice from the community. Learn where meetings will be held near you: metrotransit.org/gold-line-meetings-and-events
-  Complete an **Environmental Assessment** to identify potential benefits and impacts from the Gold Line's construction and operation and examine how to mitigate impacts. This process is expected to take two years.
-  **Design** the project with input from local communities. Completion of the design is expected to take four years.

Upcoming activities

-  **Engineering** begins when enough design and environmental work has been completed. Work to create the specifications and blueprints that will guide the construction of the project will take about two years to complete.
-  **Construction** is expected to take two years.

Gold Line service begins

-  **Gold Line service** is anticipated to begin in 2024.

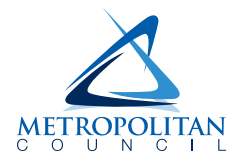
